- National Lockdown police-enforced since March 24, 2020
- Periodic extensions (every 2 weeks)
- No international flights, borders closed
- Restricted domestic travel; no public transportation
- Limited hours for businesses








What actually happened this week? (Mood)

Invest in local presence in project areas – Field Coordinators

- Ensure safety of field staff
- Engage with them more frequently
- Include when possible reduce isolation
- Maintain normal work to the extent possible





Invest in local presence in project areas – Local Partners

- Ensure safety of field staff
- Engage with them more frequently, in thematic groups
- Collaborative adjustments for activities demand driven
- Respond to COVID, but maintain overall objectives






